



Volunteer project role – videographer and editor

Chris O'Brien Lifehouse cancer hospital is looking for a volunteer videographer and editor to work on a video project for our website.

The project consists of 13 interviews (2-5 minutes each) with researchers across Chris O'Brien Lifehouse.

Each researcher will be asked to describe their research in lay terms, a bit like an elevator pitch.

Equipment provided:

- Canon EOS 70D camera
- 2 Camera lenses 50mm and 17-40mm
- Tascam voice recorder
- Tripod
- Adobe Creative Suite including Premiere
- Well-lit interview space (no lighting equipment provided)

The interviews will be scheduled across one or two days to maximise efficiency. We will have an interviewer in the room to ask questions.

Your role will be to film and edit the content. Editing can be done onsite at Chris O'Brien Lifehouse or offsite with your own software.

The final videos will be added to the new research portal on the Chris O'Brien Lifehouse website. This is a new area aimed at showcasing the cancer research we do and how it has the potential the change outcomes and improve lives for people living with cancer.
